President's Letter WHERE WE ARE WITH COVENANTS

During the past year your Board, with the assistance of legal counsel, undertook a thorough review of the three different sets of covenants that govern the 5 developments comprising the Chatterleigh Association (Chatterleigh, Brook Meadows, Hunt Club Farms, Hunt Crest Estates and Brookview Farms). The purpose for this undertaking was to provide clearer guidance to the Covenants Committee as well as to neighbors who want to improve or modify their property.

The covenants are agreements that have been in place since the original time of each development. Their purpose is to help protect the property values and the quiet enjoyment of homeowners while assuring a certain degree of consistency. These restrictive covenants run with the land; whether you are aware of them or not, you are bound by them, even if you do not pay dues. The covenants are fully enforceable as written. Here are some of the other findings and updates for your information:

The Chatterleigh Association Inc (CAI) has been assigned the right to enforcement of the covenants of all developments except Brookview Farms. The covenants of Brookview Farms require that an Architectural Review Committee (ARC)— separate from CAI's Covenants Committee — be established to weigh covenant decisions; however, it has been dormant for over a decade. Therefore it is incumbent on Brookview residents to proactively evaluate the benefits or consequences of a) reestablishing its ARC, b) authorizing a transfer of the ARC function to CAI's Covenants Committee or c) keeping its ARC dormant as it has been for many years. The CAI Board is available if Brookview Farms residents want to discuss this issue any further.

While the covenants are still in effect today — with the aforementioned exception of Brookview Farms - their enforcement has ebbed and flowed during various times in the Chatterleigh Association Inc's (CAI) history. This has no impact on their enforceability moving forward. Today, CAI has a Covenants Committee, chaired by Adrian Palazzi with assistance from Adrienne Hammel and Phil Golden. Charly Gibbons, who had very capably and generously assisted for several years, recently took on a new role on the Board. All three current Covenant Committee members are volunteers with families, jobs, and other commitments. If you would like to join us as a committee member, please contact any one of us.

There is a clearly defined submission process for reviewing proposed changes to your home or property. It is outlined below; if followed it will net you a timely review and if all is in order, a timely notice of compliance.

- o Submit a set of drawings and written narrative to the Covenants Committee Chair
- o Committee Chair reviews proposal relative to specific covenants for that neighborhood and circulates their recommendation to committee members for feedback
- o Committee Chair provides formal notification to resident (with cc: to Exec Committee members) of approval/denial within 21 days of initial submission
- Note this is not a substitute for County reviews or permits
- o If resident desires to appeal decision, then a formal meeting within 3 weeks of the decision could be requested with the Covenants Committee
- If still not satisfied with decision of Covenants Committee, a formal meeting could be requested with the Executive Committee and a final decision from CAI would be expected within 3 weeks of such request

In the past year, CAI's Covenants Committee has reviewed approximately twelve submissions – including additions, pools, fences, etc. All have been handled timely and professionally. In many cases, the completion of these projects will add to rather than detract from the neighborhood.

On occasion there may be some projects going on without our knowledge and without the proper submissions. It is the homeowner's responsibility to make a timely submission, however, as a neighbor, you can assist. If you hear that a project is going to take place, or if you see something being done, don't hesitate to call or email one of the committee members. They cannot see and/or be aware of everything that goes on unless they are notified.

When homeowners do not follow the covenants, they are NON-COMPLIANT and can face legal action. This is certainly not the first step taken or something CAI relishes; usually agreements can be reached that are consistent with the covenants. However, it is a responsibility of the Board, through the Covenants Committee to follow up on such inquiries.

We hope this update helps to inform you about one of the important functions of the board. If you would like any further information about the Covenants or the findings of our recent legal review of them please don't hesitate to contact us.


